








## Legislation

- Recklessly or negligently acting in a manner likely to endanger an aircraft or any person therein - 5 years imprisonment and or fine £5,000
- ▶ Direct or shine any light at any aircraft in flight so as to dazzle or distract the pilot of the aircraft - fine £2,500






## **Evidence Gathering**

- Specific location from flight deck
- Willingness of pilots to provide statement
- ► Timely reporting by ATC to police
- Availability of police resources to respond





### Prevention

Preferable to Enforcement

► Targeted Intervention by Police

▶ Media
